FAMILIES ANONYMOUS MOVES WORLD HEADQUARTERS

Des Plaines, IL, 10/1/2011 - Families Anonymous, a 12 Step program for the families and friends of those suffering with the issues of substance abuse or related behavioral problems has announced the relocation of their world service headquarters to Des Plaines, Illinois. The world-wide fellowship that was originally founded more than 40 years ago in Southern California, by a group of parents seeking to address the problem of drug abuse and addiction, has moved its offices to the Chicagoland area so that it can better serve their members and the recovery community.

The Families Anonymous program is a peer-to-peer self-help group that is based on the study and practice of the FA 12 Steps adapted from Alcoholics Anonymous. Members find support through group meetings and an extensive catalog of member authored, topical literature. There are no dues or fees required for participation. FA Groups are fully self-supporting through the contributions of their members and receive no outside grants or funding. With more than 500 groups world-wide, and a presence in more than 20 countries, members are able to improve their lives.

The fellowship also provides outreach through the internet by hosting a 24-hour online discussion group and several real-time online voice meetings each week. Through these online groups, FA is able to reach those who may not be able to get to the traditional group meetings, but are in need of support. Those in need are no longer alone.
